CONDITIONS AND RULES FOR CAMPING AT CAMPING 2012 GAMES LTD CAMPSITE

- 1. On arrival book in at reception. You should have a valid receipt and identification tag/pass to be placed in your vehicle window at all times. Passes will be sent out a minimum of 1 month before arrival. The Speed limit is 10 mph on site and access roads.
- **2.** Evening entertainment will include a live band and music on selected nights. However, all entertainment is subject to change at the management's discretion.
- **3.** The marquee bar will stop serving at 11.30pm and the marquee will be closed at 12 midnight. The Campsite and facilities are only open to pre-booked and paying guests of Camping 2012 Games Ltd.
- **4a.** Moderate volumes of alcohol may be brought onto, and consumed on the campsite. Campers will not be permitted to bring their own alcohol into the marquee.
- **4.** The campsite gates are closed at 11.30pm and no vehicles are admitted onto the site after that time, with acceptation of the Camping 2012 Games Mini Bus on selected nights.
- **5.** All rubbish must be removed from the site and placed in the bins provided or taken home. All grey/ black waste must be disposed of into the relevant waste points clearly marked on the campsite. Filtered grey waste water may be disposed of around the edge of the campsite field.
- **6.** Fires are not allowed, however, BBQ's can be used off the ground. Anyone found having an open fire will be asked to leave the campsite. No naked flames or cooking equipment i.e. stoves can be used within a tent.

- **15a.** Antisocial behavior will not be tolerated in, or around the campsite grounds. Anyone seen to be acting in a way that could be seen as antisocial will be asked to leave the campsite. Any criminal activity will be reported to the Police. 24hr security and CCTV will be present on the campsite.
- **15.** Anyone found to be using or supplying drugs on the campsite will be reported to the Police, and asked to leave the campsite.
- **16.** Alcohol will be sold in accordance with the 2003 Licensing Act for England and Whales. All staff serving alcohol will adopt a think 25 policy. Only Passports of Photo Card driving licenses will be accepted as valid ID. No ID no sale.
- **17a.** The amount of alcohol brought onto the campsite will be monitored. Camping 2012 Games Ltd reserve the right to carryout car searches if it is believed that excessive alcohol is being brought on to the campsite.
- **17.** The management reserves the right to refuse admission and to terminate any booking by reason of contravention of these rules.
- **18.** The cost of the bus service to local train stations is <u>NOT</u> included in the camping fee. Tickets will be available at reception at a cost of £5 per person per day.
- **19.** Persons allocated a plot on the site must state the number of nights they intend to occupy their allocated space and must pay the fees for that period before commencing occupation.

- 7. If the ground is too wet for cars, please do not attempt to park on the fields. Please park in the campsite car park. Cars are not to be parked in the areas reserved for residents or visitors of Camping 2012 Games Ltd. All vehicles must display a relevant vehicle pass issued at reception.
- 8. All plots include one car parking space and are based on two persons sharing. All extras, such as an extra person, car, awnings etc must be booked and paid for prior to arrival.
- **9.** The conduct of any form of trading from the campsite is forbidden. The site must not be used as a base for work purposes.
- **10.** Dog(s)/pets are not permitted on the campsite. Valuables are left on the campsite at campers own risk. High value items may be left at our valuables locker, and mobile phones can also be charged here. All items will be charged at £2 per item per day.
- **11.** Campers under the age of 16 are not allowed on the site unless accompanied by at least one adult over the age of 21.
- **12.** Commercial vehicles will be allowed on site only at the management's discretion.
- **13.** Noise Levels should be maintained at a reasonable level. Amplified music is not allowed on site.
- **14.** Campers shall not cause any damage to the trees, shrubs, buildings, fixtures, fittings or other property. Any accidental damage should be paid for by the camper held responsible.

- **20.** Maximum stay on site is 26 nights from 20th July 2012 to the 16th August 2012. Pitches will be available from 12 noon on the arrival date, and must be vacated by 11am following the last night stay.
- **21**. All pre-assembled tents and camping equipment will require a deposit of 50% of the hire cost, or £50 whatever is lower, to be held by Camping 2012 Games Ltd. This will be taken at reception on arrival.
- **22.** All campers must strictly adhere to the dates of their booking. Depending on availability booking dates may be changed by contacting Camping 2012 Games Ltd.
- 23. All campsite bookings include the use of all the campsite facilities. Food and drink is not included but will be available to purchase. A full range of camping equipment will be available to hire on site, for details visit www.campinggearhire.co.uk.
- **24.** A non refundable booking deposit of 50% is required upon booking. The additional 50% must be paid at least 6 months before arrival.
- **25**. The management reserves the right to cancel a booking should the full outstanding balance not be paid 6 months before arrival.
- 26. Camping 2012 Games Ltd reserve the right to cancel a booking, in this instance a full refund will be issued to the camper.
- **26.** In the event of unforeseen circumstances, such as a power cut, the management will do their utmost to rectify the issue. However campers will not be entitled to any money back or compensation.
